According to what symptoms you need to relieve, choose the one that will take care of your particular problem. Some of your choices include:

- * Corticosteroids – These should be used in moderation as they can be harsh on the skin, but applied topically in small doses they can relieve symptoms like itching and inflammation.

- * Vasoconstrictors - These are chemicals meant to mimic the effects of epinephrine. Applied topically, they reduce swelling by shrinking the blood vessels. This, in turn, may relieve pain and itching.

- * Antiseptics – These kill bacteria and keep the area clean.

- * Anesthetics, Analgesics - These relieve symptoms like burning, itching, and pain.
